Day 7

- Brazil defeat Finland 3-0 and they have now won their first three world championship matches without losing a set for the first time since 1998.
- Cuba clinched their first win at the 2014 world championship, ending a losing streak of three matches.
- They have now won all six matches against Korea at the world championship.
- Germany defeated Tunisia 3-1 with both sides making 32 errors. Germany's 32 errors accounted for almost half of Tunisia's total points (69), whereas Tunisia's 32 errors made up one-third of Germany's total points (96).
- Russia beat Mexico 3-1 to win six matches in a row for the first time since 2006. This six-match winning streak is the joint longest for them since the Soviet Union dissolved.
- China lost their 100th match at the world championship 3-0 to Bulgaria.
- This was Bulgaria's third win by a 3-0 scoreline in their last four matches.
- Canada defeated Egypt 3-0 and they have now won two matches in a row for the first time since 2006.
- Egypt equalled their longest losing streak at the world championship: seven matches (also in 1998-2006).
